

GETTING AROUND



Welcome!

Many people say they've visited Miami but only really seen South Beach. Miami-Dade County is a large area with several interesting attractions and dining options. This is a quick guide for you to easily get around Miami-Dade County safely and quickly from a local perspective.

Traveling by Bus and Metro-Rail



Most large metropolitan areas have great public transportation system; our great county is no exception! If you are staying in Miami Downtown or the beach you are in luck, you have access to metro mover for free as well as frequent buses and access to the Metro-Rail.

Most sought after attractions are on or around the downtown/beaches areas with easy access to public transportation. If you decide to stay inland you may spend most of your day on a bus, we suggest renting a car.

Traveling by Car



Some people would suggest otherwise, but in the grand scheme of things the best way to get around Miami-Dade is by car. Most of the events leading up to WrestleMania XXVIII will be all around the county, so using a car to get around will cut your travel time substantially. You could also use a mix of both private and public transportation.

First thing you need to know is that Miami-Dade County roads are on a numbered grid system, so it is easy to get around. Also we have four main highways that will take you to any part of the county. This includes I-95 and the Turnpike which both runs north and south. The 826 also known as the Palmetto Expressway runs north to south from US-1 up to the 154th Street exit then curves to run east to west ending at the Golden Glades Exchange where you can connect to either the Turnpike or I-95. Lastly, the 836 known as the Dolphin Expressway also runs east to west, which also connects to I-95 and the Turnpike.

Getting to WrestleMania Axxess

The Miami Beach Convention Center is located at 1901 Convention Center Dr., Miami Beach, FL 33139 (just east of Meridian Avenue at 17th Street)



Directions from South: Take I-95 Northbound, exit 395 East (MacArthur Causeway) to Alton Road North, right on 17th Street, left on Convention Center Drive.

Directions from North: Take I-95 Southbound, exit 195 East (Julia Tuttle Causeway) to Alton Road South, turn left on 17th Street and then turn left on Convention Center Drive.

Getting to Sun Life Stadium for WrestleMania XXVIII

From Miami

I-95 North, to North on the Florida Turnpike, to exit # 2X (Dolphin Toll Plaza), to Sun Life Stadium.

I-95 North to Ives Dairy Road, West on Ives Dairy Road for approximately 5 miles, Sun Life Stadium will be on your right.

North on the Palmetto Expressway (Route 826) to NW 27th Avenue (Route 817), proceed North on NW 27th Avenue to NW 199th Street (Dan Marino Boulevard), turn right at NW 199th Street to Sun Life Stadium.

From Ft. Lauderdale/West Palm Beach

Florida Turnpike South to exit # 2X (Sun Life Stadium Toll Plaza) to the east side of Sun Life Stadium.

Florida Turnpike South to exit # 47 (27th Avenue/University Drive); south on 27th Avenue/University Drive to the west side of Sun Life Stadium.

I-95 South to Ives Dairy Road, head west (right) for 5 miles; Sun Life Stadium will be on your right hand side.
